# The Arabian Horse Association of Qld Inc - Summer Show - Conditions of Entry

#### **General Admission Rules**

- 1. Arabian Horse Association Qld (AHAQ) Shows are conducted under the rules and regulations first and foremost by the AHSA Ltd. Rule Book and secondly as set down herein. A current version of AHSA Ltd book is available on the Society's website <a href="https://www.ahsa.asn.au">www.ahsa.asn.au</a>
- 2. All horses entered in the Arabian, Arabian Derivative and API classes Ring 1 MUST be registered with the AHSA Ltd and must be the property of the exhibitor or under an official AHSA Ltd lease.
- 3. All exhibitors showing in Ring 1 must be current financial members of AHSA Ltd. All riders, handlers, strappers, etc., must be current financial members of the AHAQ Inc or the AHSA Ltd. to be permitted to handle, ride or strap any horse at this event.
- 4. HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON ARRIVAL. Cash or EPTFOS available for entries on the day. No cheques permitted
- 5. The lodging of an entry shall bind the exhibitor to the Conditions of Entry set out herein.
- 6. The Association committee without giving any reason shall have the power to:
  - a. Reject or cancel any entry at any time
  - b. Prohibit the participation by any person or exhibit in any event or class
  - c. Alter the time or order at which any class or event is to take place
  - d. Cancel, combine or divide any event or class.
  - e. Order the removal of any exhibit from the venue
  - f. Transfer any exhibit or exhibitor from any class to another class
  - g. Act upon any report of cruelty to any exhibit on the grounds.
- 7. The Association or its agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury occurring to any exhibit or exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.
- 8. Exhibitors enter entirely at their own risk. In case any exhibit, whilst on the venue grounds, shall cause or be the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibit or the public or property of any member of the association or general public, the owner of such exhibit shall indemnify the association, it's officials and members for any loss or damage occasioned to any of them by the exhibit, the exhibitor or his/her agent.
- 9. The Association and any servant, agent or appointee of the Association shall not be held liable to an exhibitor for the death of or for any injury, damage or infection sustained by any exhibit, occasioned by or arising from any act or omission of any servant, agent or appointee of the Association done or committed in the course of making or causing to be made any test to the exhibit whether to the negligence of any such servant, agent or appointee or otherwise.
- 10. A Veterinary Surgeon shall be on call throughout the Event judging. Exhibitors or their agents are responsible for all veterinary expenses incurred.

### **General Show Rules**

- 1. Any horse deemed not in full control by its handler in the marshalling area or the ring, may be dismissed at the discretion of the chief steward. Any horse which becomes free from its handler or rider in the judging arena may be excused from its class.
- 2. Removal of a horse or pony's facial tactile/sensory hairs is prohibited.
- 3. Abuse of the whip or spurs will result in the handler/rider being required to leave the ring on the instructions of the Ring Steward. One whip mark will incur disqualification.
- 4. Any treatment to an exhibit which is considered to be inhumane should be reported immediately to an official. The Disputes Committee will examine the report, and should the incident be proven (in the opinion

of the Disputes Committee) the offenders may be disqualified, for a time to be determined, from all prize monies and trophies already gained at the Event or any other show or function controlled by the AHAQ Inc.

- 5. Two (2) calls only will be made to the marshalling yard -a warning call and a final call. Late competitors will only be allowed to enter the ring at the Chief Stewards discretion.
- 6. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure their eligibility to enter any class.
- 7. Youth is defined as a person who at close of entries has not turned 18. All exhibitors must wear safety approved helmets whilst mounted at ALL times.
- 8. API horses may compete in the Youth and Beginner rings.

#### Halter Classes

- 1. Purebred Performance horses may be shown plaited and should not be discriminated against.
- 2. Handlers are permitted to handle more than 1 horse in a class.
- 3. All stallions and colts are to have both testicles descended into the scrotum except where an entire has had one testicle surgically removed and has an appropriate Veterinary Certificate which has been submitted to the AHSA Ltd prior to the Show.
- 4. Colts and stallions whilst on the grounds must be under the control of a person 18 years or over.
- 5. Deliberate inciting of stallions to challenge will result in being excused from the class.

### **Performance Classes**

- 1. All ridden exhibits must be 3 years of age or over.
- 2. A Debut Hack is one having its first ever show appearance. To be shown in a snaffle bridle.
- 3. A Maiden Hack is one which has never won 1st prize at any official show. To be shown in a snaffle.
- 4. A Newcomer Hack is not to have competed under saddle prior to 1 January 2025. To be shown in a snaffle bridle.
- 5. A Novice Hack is a hack which has not won a first prize in any open hack class or a championship.
- 6. A Show Hunter is judged primarily on the animal's type, conformation, straightness and freedom of movement. The Show Hunter should be forward going and should exhibit a certain amount of presence, animation and impulsion at all paces. Judging priorities should be Hunter Type, Conformation, Movement, Manners, Temperament and Education. Competitors may compete in either Hack or Show Hunter classes.
- 7. All riders must wear an approved safety helmet whilst mounted at ALL times.
- 8. Beginner Classes are designed for riders/handlers who limited hacking experience or those returning to the ring after serious injury or a lengthy break from riding. The judge may ask an exhibitor to leave the beginner ring if they believe the exhibitor not to be a genuine beginner. Riders/handlers in the beginner ring are not eligible to compete in any other ring.
- Riders in these classes are encouraged to ride at the gait they are comfortable with.

### Awards, Trophies and Disputes

- 1. Awards will be made to 5th place.
- 2. All disputes must be referred to the Disputes Committee consisting of one AHAQ Inc. Committee member, the Show Manager and one Competitor. The Disputes Committee shall, in addition to any powers previously mentioned have the power to disqualify any exhibitor from any section or class for the remainder of the current Event. Such decisions are final and binding.
- 3. Protests must be lodged in writing with the AHAQ Inc Secretary together with \$50-00, which amount shall be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld. Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of the disputed decision.
